- 1. President Mark Elder opened the meeting at 9:01 AM on Wednesday December 2, 2020.

- **6.** Handicap Chair Report: Kevin Reno

- 7. Greens Committee Report: Joe Jansen
 - Financials in March, April, and May were losing months due to Covid. June, July, and August saw revenue improve. By the end of October we were \$150K to the good. (Revenue vs. Expenses)
 - Robert has operated \$200K under budget for the year. Given the excellent course conditions this was an extraordinary job. Well done, Robert.
 - Revenue in prior years had run 50% 50% members vs. outside play. Currently revenue is 38% member, 62% outside play. It requires \$2.5 million revenue annually to run the club.
 - Pro-shop credits must be used by Monday 12/14.
 - The stream on number 6 has been filled with gravel. This is a hazard and we are asked not to play out of the stream. Take a drop.
 - A new range net will be installed at a cost of \$30K.
 - Cup ball lifters will be demoed on the practice green prior to ordering them for the course.
 - There is a Member-At-Large opening on the Greens Committee. This will be offered to the membership this month.
