

WELCOME TO **TENNIS** AT THE VILLAGE OF OAKCREEK ASSOCIATION (VOCA)



The VOCA Tennis Court is available for use every day. The court may be used for organized groups and non-organized groups or for the use of the ball machine.

A membership in the VOCA Courts Club allows you to play Tennis and/or Pickleball. Non-members must pay a daily fee (\$10) at the courts, placed into the collection box on the pickleball side of the courts. The fee is per-person.

Members can reserve times through OnlineCourtReservations.com. Non-members can reserve through the VOCA office Monday-Friday only. You may play if you do not have a reservation but if someone who does have a reservation comes along, they have the right to bump your game when their time starts. Finish your current game and then cede the court to the reserved players.

For courtesy, while waiting for the court to be available, reserved players should wait outside the fence while the current players finish their game.

Long-term weekly reservations can be made, subject to VOCA approval. Inquire at the VOCA office for introductions to specific tennis players who have organized foursomes. Reservations can be made for up to 30 days in advance.

General Court Rules & Procedures

- Use courts at your own risk
- Court shoes only. No hiking boots, flip flops, or other hard-soled shoes are allowed.
- Courts are to be used for Tennis and Pickleball only. No skateboards, bikes, roller skates, in-line skates, other sports, childcare, or any activities that may damage the courts.
- No pets inside the fence
- Court surface may be slippery if wet or icy. Proceed with caution!
- No food or alcohol. Dispose of all trash in container.
- Restrooms and water filling station located just outside the courts
- Do not open the gate and let in anyone without a member key FOB without collecting the \$10 daily fee.
