From the Director of Golf Course Operations:

Now that summer is in full swing, I would like to take this opportunity to update everyone on course conditions and programs moving forward.

We have fertilized fairways and they are responding well. Our weed control program will continue through the summer.

Our greens continue to perform well and many have said they are the best in our area. Recent soil test results have identified some deficiencies and amendments will be applied to address these. Some of you have inquired about sand on the greens and why we apply it. The process is known as topdressing and actually dates back hundreds of years to Scotland, in the time of Old Tom Morris.

Basically there are three main reasons we top-dress. The first two are for smoothness and firmness, and they have to do with playability. Sand fills depressions and any voids, and is worked in to fill these areas making the green smoother and helping the ball roll with decreased bounce. Sand also prevents greens from becoming soft or spongy, firming them up to prevent ball marks, footprints and scalping by mowers. The final reason for topdressing is purely agronomic and probably the most important. Sand helps to control thatch. Thatch is defined as un-decomposed and living organic material above the soil surface. Thatch prevents water from entering the soil. Excess thatch harbors insects and disease. It ties up herbicides and insecticides, decreasing their effectiveness.

Due to our limited staff, we actually do not top dress as often as we could, and we have to apply at a heavier rate when done. Topdressing is a vital tool in the management of Bermuda grass putting surfaces. No one likes to putt on sand, but for these reasons it has always and will continue to be done.

I want to thank everyone for the many positive comments my staff receives. They are some of the hardest working people I know. Thank you also to our volunteers. Thank you to our owners and members for your continued support as well.
